D	ouring Meal Preparations-
Cook-#1	Prepares the assigned meal as per the menu prepared by the Patrol Leader.
Assistant Cook Prep- #2	Helps Cook prepare the assigned meal as per the menu prepared by the Patrol Leader.
Meal Prep	Helps the Cook and Assistant get the meal prepared by cleaning any vegetables, opening packages, measuring ingredients, etc. Sets the table with plates and cups. After meal gets all dishes prepared for washing
Fireman/Fire Marshal	Responsible for preparing the charcoal for Dutch oven cooking.  Also responsible to make sure the Dutch oven is dried and oiled properly after it has been washed. Serves as Fire Marshal for open fires
Clean I	Up- Tub #1-3 as followed [2-3 scouts]-
Tub #1 (White bin)	Cleans all utensils, pots and pans in the soapy water, and makes sure that everyone scrapes their bowls and plates before cleaning. *When cleaning Dutch oven cleaner will ONLY use Crisco and hot water.
Tub #2 (Black bin)	Cleans the dishes with cool water and bleach and prepares the dishes to go into the next bin
Tub #3 (White bin)	Cleans the dishes with warm water
Bef	fore and After Meal Preparations-
Stove and Water Manager (2 people)	Makes sure the stove is set before the meal, and makes sure that the water jugs are filled, and puts water on for cleanup.
Chuck Box Technician/QM	Dries all dishes. Puts the chuck box back together and places the pots and pans in their specific locations. If applicable makes sure Dutch oven is clean and dry and stored properly. Repormissing/damaged equipment to Troop QM.
